TRY OUT DATES:

THE FOLLOWING ARE THE DATES FOR THE TRY OUTS FOR THE 2007-08 SEASON FOR ALL AGE GROUPS.

Saturday, Nov. 10, Cell. One 9-noon Try out fee is \$10.00

JV Silver----those who are currently playing on your high school C teams and selected 8th graders should try out for this division. Any 8th graders trying out for this division should have at least 2 years of junior volleyball experience. Those trying out for this division and selected will either stay in this division or be moved up to the JV Gold division. If you are currently on your high school C team, this is the division that you must try out for to start. If we decide to move you up, we will.

Saturday, Nov. 17, Cell One 9-noon Try out fee is \$10.00

JV Gold division---those who are currently on their high school JV's may try out for this division. Based on your experience, if you are selected, you will play in this division or be moved to the JV Silver division or the Varsity Silver division.

Saturday, Nov. 17th, Cell One, 1-4 pm Try out fee is \$10.00

Varsity division---those who played on their high school varsity this season. If you are selected from this group, you will play in the Varsity Gold or the Varsity Silver division or based on your experience and skill level, be moved to the JV Gold division.

These are the only dates for these try outs. There are no make ups. Please try out for the division for the level that you played in high school. If selected, we can move you up a division if need be but you must stay in the groupings that we have assigned so that we can manage the numbers. Please understand that whatever level that you played in high school does not mean you will be selected for the same level in Midnight Sun as we take kids from Anchorage and the Valley and the number of kids trying out are huge.

12s-13s-and 14's divisions—Saturday, December 8th, Cell. One. Try out fee is \$10.00

9-11:30----any 5th and 6th graders

12:30 to 3:00—7th graders

3:30-6:00---8th graders and those selected 9th graders who did not make the JV division. If selected in this division, you might be placed in the 12/13's which are 6th graders and those 7th graders moved down, the 13/14 division which are mostly 7th graders and those 8th graders who are moved down, and the 14's which are mainly 8th graders with a few 7th and 9th graders sprinkled in.
